Yá'át'ééh Parents, Guardians, and Community members of Ganado Primary School,

Here at Ganado Primary School, we are implementing our Beyond Textbook curriculum. Our teachers are teaching to the state standards, which is aligned to our school calendar. Each grade level has a list of weekly standards, which they must teach and assess for mastery and assist those who need additional help.

We also began our Reteach & Enrich program, which provides additional assistance in the areas of Math and Language Arts. ELA is every morning from 8:45-9:15am; Math is every morning as follows: Kindergarten 10:20-10:50am; 1st 1:30-2pm; 2nd 12:45-1:15pm.

It is imperative that parents and guardians help us by reading to your child and allowing your child to read to you. Encourage your child recite words to you. According to the Annie E. Casey Foundation, "three quarters of students who are poor readers in third grade will remain poor readers in high school, according to the research of Yale University". (2010)

Encourage your child to attend school every day and to be on time. Breakfast is served in the cafeteria at 7:50am; instruction begins promptly at 8:30am. A student is tardy if they arrive after 8:40am. Be on time. Do not drop off students before 7:45am.

We will no longer provide the "wait in gym", parents you are responsible for arrangements for your child/children after school. Teachers are meeting with their grade level to plan, analyze, discuss academic data and make plans for school improvement. As a school identified as a school in "School Improvement", this time is precious to us.

Next week, we have Parent Teacher Conference (February 7, 2024), its will be an Early Release day, we look forward to seeing you. This is a great time to speak with your child's teacher.
