





GANADO USD GOVERNING BOARD RESPONSE TO AUDITOR GENERAL'S REPORT

The Ganado USD Governing Board would like to greet our students, staff, parents, grandparents, relatives, and stakeholders through K'e (A System of Kinship) and address raised concerns of the findings in the recent Arizona Auditor General's report for Ganado USD. The Governing Board reviewed and accepted the findings and conclusions of the Arizona Auditor General's Report for Fiscal Year 2019 through January 2023 in Report No. 23-205 on November 16, 2023. The Board acknowledges that there is always room for improvement in the operation of our schools, and the Board is committed to continued improvement. The period of this audit report encompassed the entirety of the COVID-19 coronavirus pandemic, which was a difficult and trying time for all schools, particularly those on the Navajo Nation. The Board takes its oversight responsibilities seriously and has, and will continue to, act in the best interest of all District students.

There is a corrective action plan in place and the Governing Board is committed to continuing to work with the Auditor General's office to remedy all audit findings and ensure the identified deficiencies will not be repeated. This responsibility falls on all of us, and we are committed to addressing these findings as a team without assigning blame to individuals. Our goal is to move forward and implement solutions to improve each year. We appreciate all the support and understanding as the district works toward addressing these challenges. The Governing Board plans to follow our district mission to ensure all students a quality education and strengthen Dine' Cultural values for life-long learning. Together, we will strive to make positive changes for the benefit of our district and community. 
- Supervision begins at 7:45 a.m. Please do not bring your child to school before 7:45 a.m.

- Parents and Students: A reminder that we enforce the No Solid Bag policy in the building. Please see page 16 of our Parent/Student Handbook. This goes for school bags and athletic bags. Student bags will be confiscated and parents will need to pick them up.
- Each morning, GHS conducts a tardy sweep. All students arriving to school late without a valid written excuse are assigned to ISS for 1st period.
- Student attendance is very important to earning a grade in class. If a student has 10 or more absences (excused or unexcused) they will receive No Credit (NC) and will have to retake their course in summer school or credit recovery.
- Afterschool tutoring and credit recovery is offered Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, students can see the Tutoring Calendar in Hornetland to see which teachers are available.
- There is no activity bus on Early Release or Delayed Schedule days.
- Encourage students to be kind and respectful to fellow students and our dedicated staff members. If students need assistance, we have staff members that can help.

Winter Safety Tips:

- Allow extra time in the morning to get to your bus stop on time.
- Wear bright clothing so the bus driver and other motorists can see you in the early morning and late evening.
- Stand away from where the bus stops. Buses need extra room to stop when there is snow and ice.
- Dress properly. Winter clothing, hats, mittens and boots will help keep you warm.
- Don't play in the snow while waiting for the bus.
- Don't throw snowballs at the bus or anyone else.
- Don't slide on the snow or ice patches in driveways or on the street. You could slide under the wheel of the bus or onto the street and get hurt.
- Don't push or shove around the bus. Someone could fall on the ice and get hurt.
