## Educational Plan

Ganado Unified School District is going fully digital 3-12. In grades Prek-2 they are posting their assignments online. Grades 3-12 will deliver their instruction via google classroom beginning the week of April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020. This will allow for real-time as well as asynchronous instruction. Students will need to logon for approximately an hour a week to gather their activities.

### Principal Responsibilities:

- Supervising Classroom (digital instruction)
- Documenting teacher activity in google classroom
- Monitoring instruction is provided and gradebooks are up to date.

### The Teachers Responsibility:

- Logon and update Google Classroom Weekly or in the case of K-2 weekly communication with the principal and parents.
- Maintain Pacing Guides
- Review and reflect upon data
- Keep a grade book as grades will be submitted

### Paraprofessionals Responsibilities:

- Work with the teachers to prepare intervention activities.
- Weekly call or email to supervisor

### Other Opportunities

Many of our students will be using AR 360 to help supplement reading instruction as well as ALEKS to help supplement their math instruction. In many cases teachers also sent home workbooks and packets. Also they are able to upload educational opportunities to the website.
