## Child Find Screening 2021-2022



Date: February 8, 2022 (8:30 am—11:30 am) (by appointment only)


**What is Child Find?**

Child Find is a component of the Individuals with Disability Education Act (IDEA' 04) that requires Public Education Agencies (PEA) to locate, identify, and evaluate all children with disabilities, aged birth through 21, located within their boundaries of responsibility who are in need of early intervention or special education services.

**When do we have Child Find Screenings?**

Every 45 days our school hold Developmental Screenings for children birth to 5 years of age, whose legal guardian suspects a disability and who are not currently enrolled in a GUSD public school. The event will be on the school district campus and contact GUSD school to find location.

For applicants not eligible to vote (applicants under the age of 18), a copy of a parent or guardian's Navajo Nation Voter registration Card will be sufficient to fulfill the registered Navajo Nation Voter requirement.
