Ganado Unified School District Response to COVID-19 Surge									
<b>Ganado, AZ-</b> The Superintendent, Dr. Betsy Dobias, met with Sage Hospital at noon today. After careful consideration and gathering of factual information due to the rising COVID case numbers, Dr. Dobias has deemed it necessary to have students remain remote/virtual until <b>January 31st</b> , <b>2022.</b> Since Ganado Unified School District has been on virtual instruction, this week will remain as planned. On Tuesday, January 18th, a drive-through packet distribution will be conducted on campuses for grades K-8. There will be a second distribution will be conducted on Monday, January 24th. High School students will be accommodated in multiple ways to meet their needs as most students will log into Edgenuity or their Google Classroom to complete classwork. Ganado High School Pavilion will be open for students who do not have access to the internet Monday through Thursdays from $8:00 \text{ a.m.} - 1:00 \text{ p.m.}$ The Pavilion will be closed on January 17, 2022, due to the Holiday. Since the district will not be running buses, the district will provide packets for those students who cannot use the internet, do not have access to the internet, or for those who cannot come to the school. This distribution is only for the students who typically attend school in person and those students who are enrolled to attend online classes will remain the same. If your child is a remote learner, nothing will change regarding their instruction. <u>Therefore, it is paramount that while your child is on remote learning, they complete the attached attendance attestation form.</u> We will continue to serve lunch at the locations attached.									
Effective immediately, Ganado Middle School athletics programs are canceled. Ganado High school athletes will continue the athletics program upon negative testing which will be conducted weekly or more, depending on scheduled games. In addition, each athlete will be given two tickets, and only parents or guardians will be allowed to attend athletic events. Dr. Betsy Dobias (Superintendent) and the Athletic Director Lynette Lookingback have communicated regarding this issue and feel it is in the best interest of student safety to allow their parents to attend athletic events. In addition, we will allow for two tickets per player for the visiting team. Please see attached, the Athletic Director statement.									
The intent of this is not to cause panic within the Ganado community and surrounding areas, however Ganado Unified School District is being proactive due to the potential of school COVID-19 transmission. Also, knowing that schools have been assigned a red status which is different from being under red level as the entire Navajo Nation, which is under orange Status at the time of this letter publication. Therefore, we follow the guidelines set forth in Navajo Nation Public Health Order 2022-02. Ganado Unified School District and Sage Hospital have been committed to maintaining open lines of communication and our positive relationship.									
Please note that staff will be reporting to work	during this time and will	be available to students and parents.							
Please understand that any plans at this point are very subject to change due to the unpredictability of this virus we will work to keep our Hornet family informed as soon as we are able.
