Ganado Unified School District Response to COVID-19 Surge

Ganado, AZ-After looking at the case numbers on the Navajo Nation, the past two weeks Ganado Unified School District Superintendent Dr. Betsy Dobias has deemed it necessary to have students remain remote/virtual until February 14th, 2022. There will not be any instructional delivery changes since Ganado Unified School District has been on virtual instruction. On Mondays, there will be packet distribution at each school site. High school students will be accommodated in multiple ways to meet their needs. Most students will log into Edgenuity or their Google Classroom. The Pavilion will be open for students without internet Monday through Thursdays from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., each day. As we are not running buses, we will also provide packets for those who cannot use or access the internet and cannot come to the school. This distribution is only for the students who typically attend school in person. If your child is a remote learner, nothing will change regarding their instruction. Therefore, it is paramount that while your child is on remote learning, they complete the attached attendance attestation form. We will continue to serve lunch at the locations attached.

Effective immediately, Middle School athletics are canceled. Please understand that administration has used the concept that if the Middle School students can physically attend school, there can be Middle School athletics. High school athletes will continue to rapid test weekly, if not more, depending on scheduled games. In addition, each athlete will be given two tickets, and only parents or guardians will be allowed to attend athletic events. Dr. Betsy Dobias (Superintendent) and Athletic Director Lynette Lookingback have communicated regarding this issue and feel it is in the best interest of student safety to allow their parents to attend athletic events. In addition, we will allow for two tickets per player for the visiting team.

The intent of this is not to cause panic within the Ganado community and surrounding areas. Schools can have the potential of having transmission, and we are being proactive. Ganado Unified School District and Sage Hospital have been committed to maintaining open lines of communication and a positive relationship.

Please understand that any plans at this point are very subjective to change due to the unpredictability of this virus. We will work to keep our Hornet family informed as soon as we are able.

What is Child Find?

Child Find is a component of the Individuals with Disability Education Act (IDEA' 04) that requires Public Education Agencies (PEA) to locate, identify, and evaluate all children with disabilities, aged birth through 21, located within their boundaries of responsibility who are in need of early intervention or special education services.

When do we have Child Find Screenings?

Every 45 days our school hold Developmental Screenings for children birth to 5 years of age, whose legal guardian suspects a disability and who are not currently enrolled in a GUSD public school. The event will be on the school district campus and contact GUSD school to find location.
