## STEP-1

CHECK WITH SCHOOL NURSE ASSISTANT

 SUBMIT <u>IMMUNIZATIONS</u> TO SCHOOL NURSE FOR REVIEW. (NURSE WILL COPY AND SEND AN ADDITIONAL COPY TO THE SCHOOL REGISTRAR.) IMMUNIZATION MUST BE APPROVED PRIOR TO ENROLLMENT.

- 6. \*Residence Verification Form
- 7. \*Proof of Residency or Shared Residence

- Asking for help is only the first step. YOU have to put in the rest of the work.


