Hello Ganado High School Students and Families,

Our teachers have worked to provide activities for students using our online Google Classroom. A Google Classroom app is also available for smartphones and tablets to make it easier for students to find their classes. Students will use their Hornetland accounts to access all materials for their classes. No paper packets will be issued to protect the health of our employees, students, and their families. At this time, we are only providing this method of learning due to the Stay at Home order issued by the Navajo Nation and recommendations for schools from the State of Arizona.

We understand that the online method of delivery will not work for everyone, but we hope that if you have internet at home or on your smartphones, that you use this resource as much as possible to help your student access their assignments. Many assignments will not need to be printed and can be completed in the Google Classroom or students may use paper and pencil/pen and handwrite their assignments. We also have a list of alternatives for students if a student does not have a device or internet access. Most assignments being provided are for enrichment and reinforcement. These are topics that many students have already learned and experienced prior to the closure and they are familiar with the types of assignments teachers are providing.

Alternative Education and Credit Recovery continue to be available through our Edgenuity system. Students already enrolled in Edgenuity courses already have

their usernames and passwords to access the system. Students may continue to work on their courses immediately. We will not enroll any new students to the system at this time.

Our teachers are able to be reached through the Google classroom via email or messaging by students. You may also contact teachers via their school email as well. A directory is located on the district website High school page. Teachers may facilitate help for students that need assistance with passwords or students may contact them for further explanation of the assignment. We will also add to this webpage, a list of individuals to contact for help with passwords for Google Classroom, AR360, ALEKS, and Edgenuity.

As much as our teachers have planned, we do not want to overwhelm our students as they learn to adapt to this new way of learning. We ask parents to do their best in finding opportunities for their students to learn using the resources that we have provided.

I am most appreciative of our teachers and staff for their continued dedication, commitment, and adaptability to this new way of providing educational experiences for our students. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we face this challenge and may you all continue to be blessed with good health and safety for yourself and your families.
