Dr. Thomas stated that she sent the information regarding the 4th year school improvement letter and recommends the district enter into the ELEVATE Program, where the Primary Schools and High Schools are able to participate in the program. She stated that they would proceed in a 2-year cohort and 3-days out of the week for the school year. Mrs. Teresa Gorman motions to table the item as this is a discussion for the full board. 
